Mrs John A. Feick Cheyenne Wyo. Terr. Dear Sister:

I received your letter yesterday morning and was very glad to hear from you. Mary Boesch and Mike will be married tomorrow morning at nine o'clock. Katie Wagner is a going to be brides-maid and I don't know who is groom-man. Endrec named her twins both Joe. I don't know how she will tell them apart. Oh I forgot to tell you Pa is invited and Joe also to Boesch wedding and I think they are both going Pa spoke of getting them a bed-spread. We are having our porch fixed up and a new seat in the water closet and a new pump in the kitchen and several other little things fixed up.
