

VACCUUMING	DATE:																												
GET OUT VACCUUM(S) & attachments if needed																													
STRATEGY: Don't vaccuum coins, marbles, paper clips, etc. PICK THEM UP! Work around each room. If vaccuum isn't picking up dirt properly, you need to change/empty the bag. The dirt on carpets comes in on your feet. Leave the dirt at the door! Wipe your feet and take off those treads with the dirt that falls out of them for days.																													
USE VACCUUM WITH BEATER ON ALL CARPETING EVEN UP THE STAIRS. To get the edges use damp cloth or vaccuum wand occassionally
